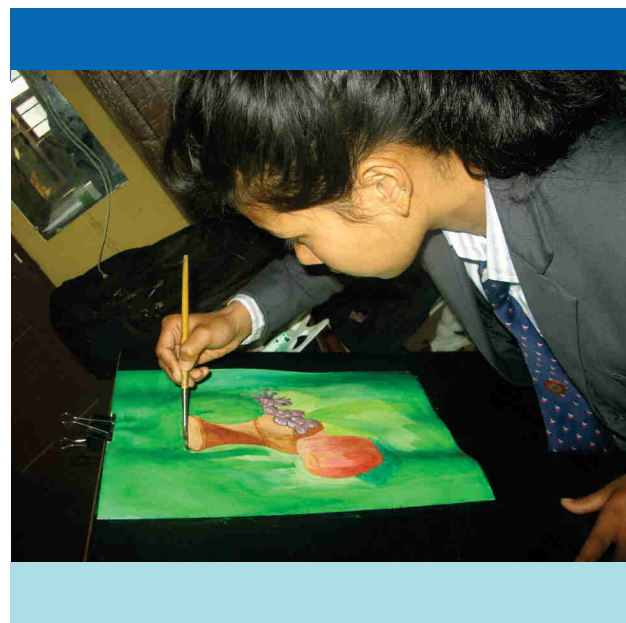


Admission Procedures

- For admission in Science stream, students with average grade 'B' (minimum 2.8 GPA) in SEE and with grade B (2.8 GPA) in C. English, Mathematics, Science and Opt. Maths will be considered eligible.
- For admission in Management, Humanities and Education Streams, students with average grade 'D+' (minimum 1.6 GPA) in SEE will be considered eligible.
- SEE graduates should attend and pass the entrance exam set forth by the Joint Examination Committee Bhaktapur.
- The successful students must attend the interview with the original SEE documents.

Evaluation Procedures

- Various home and class assignments to be completed within the stipulated time frame.
- Compulsory attendance in various diagnostic and terminal examinations.
- Maintenance of 90% of the total class attendance.
- Strict discipline (in uniform, hairstyle, manner, punctuality and regularity).

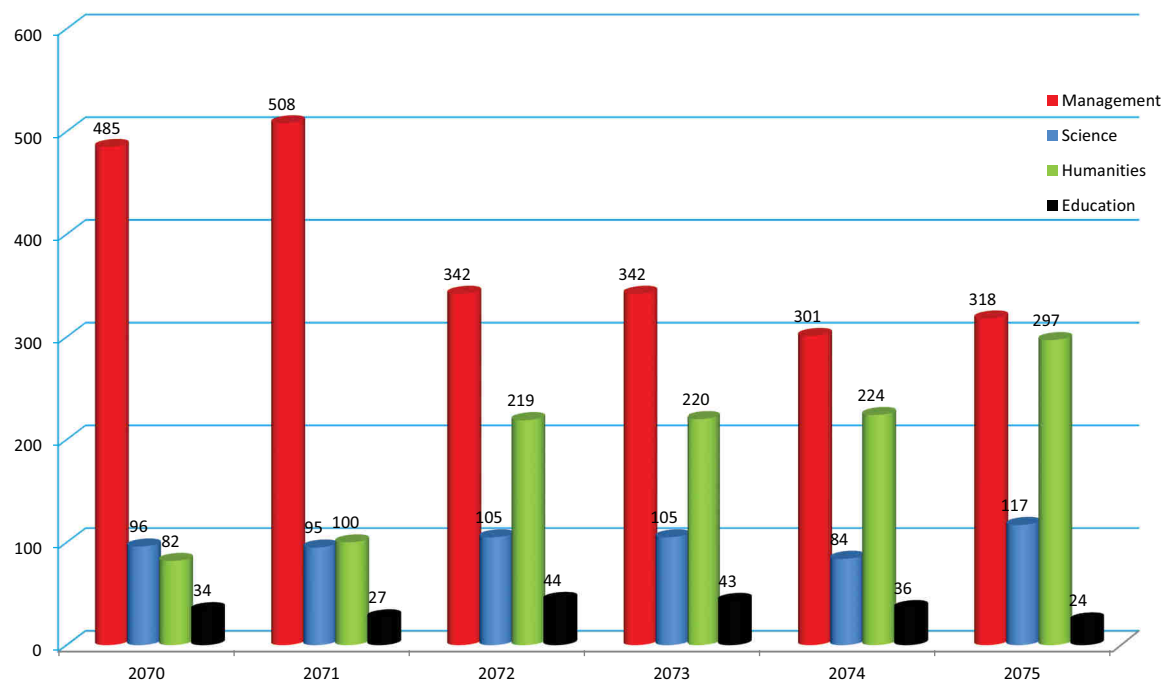
